Mean depth - 10 feet

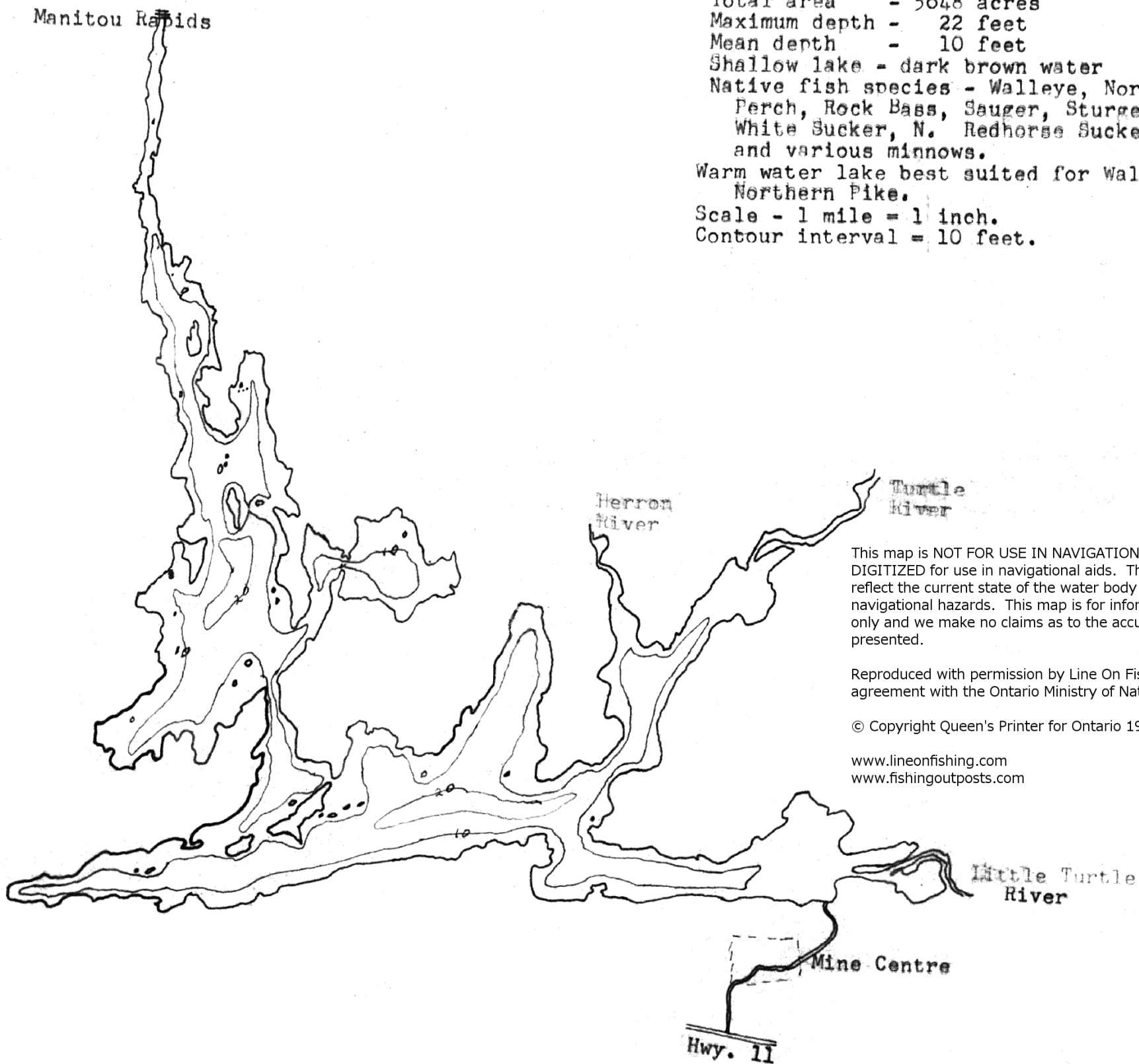
Shallow lake - dark brown water

Native fish species - Walleye, Northern Pike,
Perch, Rock Bass, Sauger, Sturgeon, Cisco,
White Sucker, N. Redhorse Sucker, Mooneye,
and various minnows.

Warm water lake best suited for Walleye and
Northern Pike.

Scale - 1 mile = 1 inch.

Contour interval = 10 feet.
